MINOR INJURIES PROCEDURE

ALWAYS REMEMBER:

- DO NOT TOUCH OR SPEAK CLOSE TO THE WOUND;
- DO NOT USE COTTON (its fibers can infect the wound);
- DO NOT USE ALCOHOL (it burns the edges and complicates the suture);
- DO NOT APPLY CREAMS OR OINMENTS
 WITH ANTIBIOTICS.DO NOT SEARCH
 WITHIN THE WOUND, OR REMOVE NAILED
 OBJECTS (they will be immobilized if
 possible);
- DO NOT SCRATCH OR CLEAN CLOTS. THE USE OF OXYGENATED WATER IS RESTRICTED TO ITS CAPACITY AS HOMEOSTASIC (stop bleeding).
